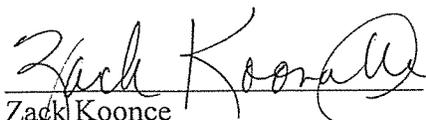
COMMISSIONERS ABSENT:

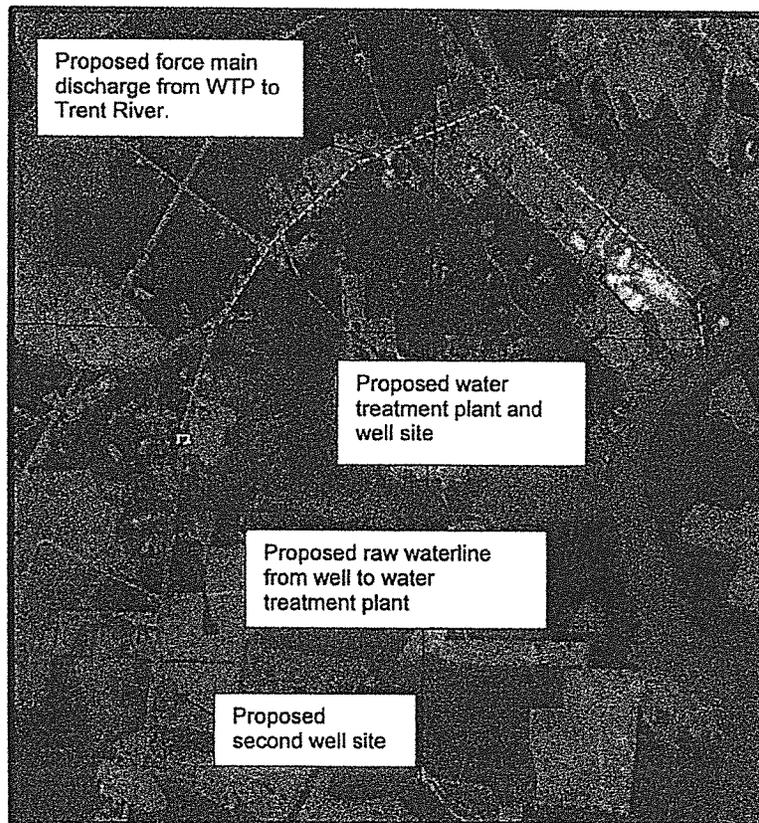
1. The Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) has been approved by USDA. The approved report is based on constructing a Water Treatment Plant for water provided from the Castle Hayne Aquifer. The project includes two Castle Hayne Water Supply Wells and one elevated storage tank on the water treatment plant site.
 - a. Deviation from the PER will involve significant time and reconsideration of funding.
2. We have contacted Dr. Richard Spruill as he perhaps has the most knowledge of the aquifer systems in eastern NC. He has provided water quality data from water samples from the well field used for the City of New Bern Water Treatment Plant.
 - a. Dr. Spruill indicates that water quality and quantity potentially declines as you move south from US 70.
3. We next contacted the NC Division of Environmental Quality concerning the NPDES permit required for the water treatment plant waste discharge. I spoke with the branch supervisor, Tom Belnick. Tom stated NCDEQ has an agreement with other state agencies to not allow discharge of salt water to fresh waters. He suggested I speak with Julie Grzyb with NPDES Complex Permitting Staff. She provided the same response and stated it would be very difficult to obtain a permit to discharge a salt solution to fresh water, especially due to the waters being also classified as Swamp Waters with low velocities and Nutrient Sensitive Waters.
4. The transition point of the Trent River being classified from salt water to fresh water occurs at the Jones County / Craven County line. Therefore we will need to construct a pipeline from the water treatment plant to the Trent River at or east of the county line.
 - a. We will likely need to purchase an easement from a private landowner or landowners in order to reach the river from existing rights-of-way.
5. The project will require the purchase of two sites.
 - a. One site will house the water treatment plant, one water supply well and a elevated storage tank. The size of the site will need to be approximately 600 feet by 400 feet (5.5 acres).
 - b. A separate well site is needed with approximate dimensions of 225 feet by 225 feet (1.1 acres).
 - c. We have contacted three landowners to date for preliminary discussion, but have not made any monetary offers.
 - d. We desire to have land appraised before making a sales offer for the sites. We have obtained the services for an appraiser through the procurement process.
6. **Requested Action:** Motion approving Project Engineer to proceed with land appraisals and contacting land owners for the procurement of property needed for the project.

1.2 Environmental Resources Present

In general, Jones County's rural characteristics are such that environmental resources are not a significant presence. Project planning area is represented by upgrades to the County's rural water distribution system and installation of new supply, storage and treatment facilities. Project objective is to increase water supply capability to allow the County to meet water shortage projections created by groundwater restrictions imposed by Central Coastal Plain Capacity Use Area (CCPCUA) rules and meet long-term water demand needs (reasonable growth). Proposed project scoping is to meet current demands and not to increase customer base (beyond reasonable growth). Construction will be confined to public road rights-of-way and/or dedicated land/easements. Land disturbance will be minimal (confined to temporary trench needed to install water system assets lines) such that no long-term adverse impact will occur to any existing environmental resources.

Specific to the project planning area, Jones County does have areas where floodplains, wetlands and prime/important farmland exist. The following map exhibits provide information on existing environmental resources relative to proposed project scoping:

DWR PRIMARY SURFACE WATER CLASSIFICATIONS

All surface waters in North Carolina are assigned a primary classification by the NC Division of Water Resources (DWR). All waters must at least meet the standards for Class C (fishable / swimmable) waters. The other primary classifications provide additional levels of protection for primary water contact recreation (Class B) and drinking water (Water Supply Classes I through V). To find the classification of a particular water body you can either use the BIMS database or contact Adriene Weaver of the Classifications & Standards/Rules Review Branch. Class C

Waters protected for uses such as secondary recreation, fishing, wildlife, fish consumption, aquatic life including propagation, survival and maintenance of biological integrity, and agriculture. Secondary recreation includes wading, boating, and other uses involving human body contact with water where such activities take place in an infrequent, unorganized, or incidental manner.

Class B

Waters protected for all Class C uses in addition to primary recreation. Primary recreational activities include swimming, skin diving, water skiing, and similar uses involving human body contact with water where such activities take place in an organized manner or on a frequent basis.

Water Supply I (WS-I)

Waters protected for all Class C uses plus waters used as sources of water supply for drinking, culinary, or food processing purposes for those users desiring maximum protection for their water supplies. WS-I waters are those within natural and undeveloped watersheds in public ownership. All WS-I waters are HQW by supplemental classification. More information:

Water Supply II (WS-II)

Waters used as sources of water supply for drinking, culinary, or food processing purposes where a WS-I classification is not feasible. These waters are also protected for Class C uses. WS-II waters are generally in predominantly undeveloped watersheds. All WS-II waters are HQW by supplemental classification. More information: [Water Supply Watershed Protection Program Homepage](#)

Water Supply III (WS-III)

Waters used as sources of water supply for drinking, culinary, or food processing purposes where a more protective WS-I or II classification is not feasible. These waters are also protected for Class C uses. WS-III waters are generally in low to moderately developed watersheds. Water Supply IV (WS-IV)

Waters used as sources of water supply for drinking, culinary, or food processing purposes where a WS-I, II or III classification is not feasible. These waters are also protected for Class C uses. WS-IV waters are generally in moderately to highly developed watersheds or Protected Areas. Water Supply V (WS-V)

Waters protected as water supplies which are generally upstream and draining to Class WS-IV waters or waters used by industry to supply their employees with drinking water or as waters formerly used as water supply. These waters are also protected for Class C uses. Class WL

Freshwater Wetlands are a subset of all wetlands, which in turn are waters that support vegetation that is adapted to life in saturated soil conditions. Wetlands generally include swamps, marshes, bogs, and similar areas. These waters are protected for storm and flood water storage, aquatic life, wildlife, hydrologic functions, filtration and shoreline protection.

Class SC

All tidal salt waters protected for secondary recreation such as fishing, boating, and other activities involving minimal skin contact; fish and noncommercial shellfish consumption; aquatic life propagation and survival; and wildlife.

Class SB

Tidal salt waters protected for all SC uses in addition to primary recreation. Primary recreational activities include swimming, skin diving, water skiing, and similar uses involving human body contact with water where such activities take place in an organized manner or on a frequent basis.

Class SA

Tidal salt waters that are used for commercial shellfishing or marketing purposes and are also protected for all Class SC and Class SB uses. All SA waters are also HQW by supplemental classification.

Class SWL

These are saltwaters that meet the definition of coastal wetlands as defined by the Division of Coastal Management and which are located landward of the mean high water line or wetlands contiguous to estuarine waters as defined by the Division

of Coastal Management.

DWR SUPPLEMENTAL CLASSIFICATIONS

Supplemental classifications are sometimes added by DWR to the primary classifications to provide additional protection to waters with special uses or values.

Future Water Supply (FWS)

Supplemental classification for waters intended as a future source of drinking, culinary, or food processing purposes. FWS would be applied to one of the primary water supply classifications (WS-I, WS-II, WS-III, or WS-IV). Currently no water bodies in the state carry this designation.

High Quality Waters (HQW)

Supplemental classification intended to protect waters which are rated excellent based on biological and physical/chemical characteristics through Division monitoring or special studies, primary nursery areas designated by the Marine Fisheries Commission, and other functional nursery areas designated by the Marine Fisheries Commission.

The following waters are HQW by definition:

- WS-I,
- WS-II,
- SA (commercial shellfishing),
- ORW,
- Primary nursery areas (PNA) or other functional nursery areas designated by the Marine Fisheries Commission, or
- Waters for which DWR has received a petition for reclassification to either WS-I or WS-II.

Outstanding Resource Waters (ORW)

All outstanding resource waters are a subset of High Quality Waters. This supplemental classification is intended to protect unique and special waters having excellent water quality and being of exceptional state or national ecological or recreational significance. To qualify, waters must be rated Excellent by DWR and have one of the following outstanding resource values:

- Outstanding fish habitat and fisheries,
- Unusually high level of waterbased recreation or potential for such kind of recreation,
- Some special designation such as North Carolina Natural and Scenic River or National Wildlife Refuge,
- Important component of state or national park or forest, or
- Special ecological or scientific significance (rare or endangered species habitat, research or educational areas).

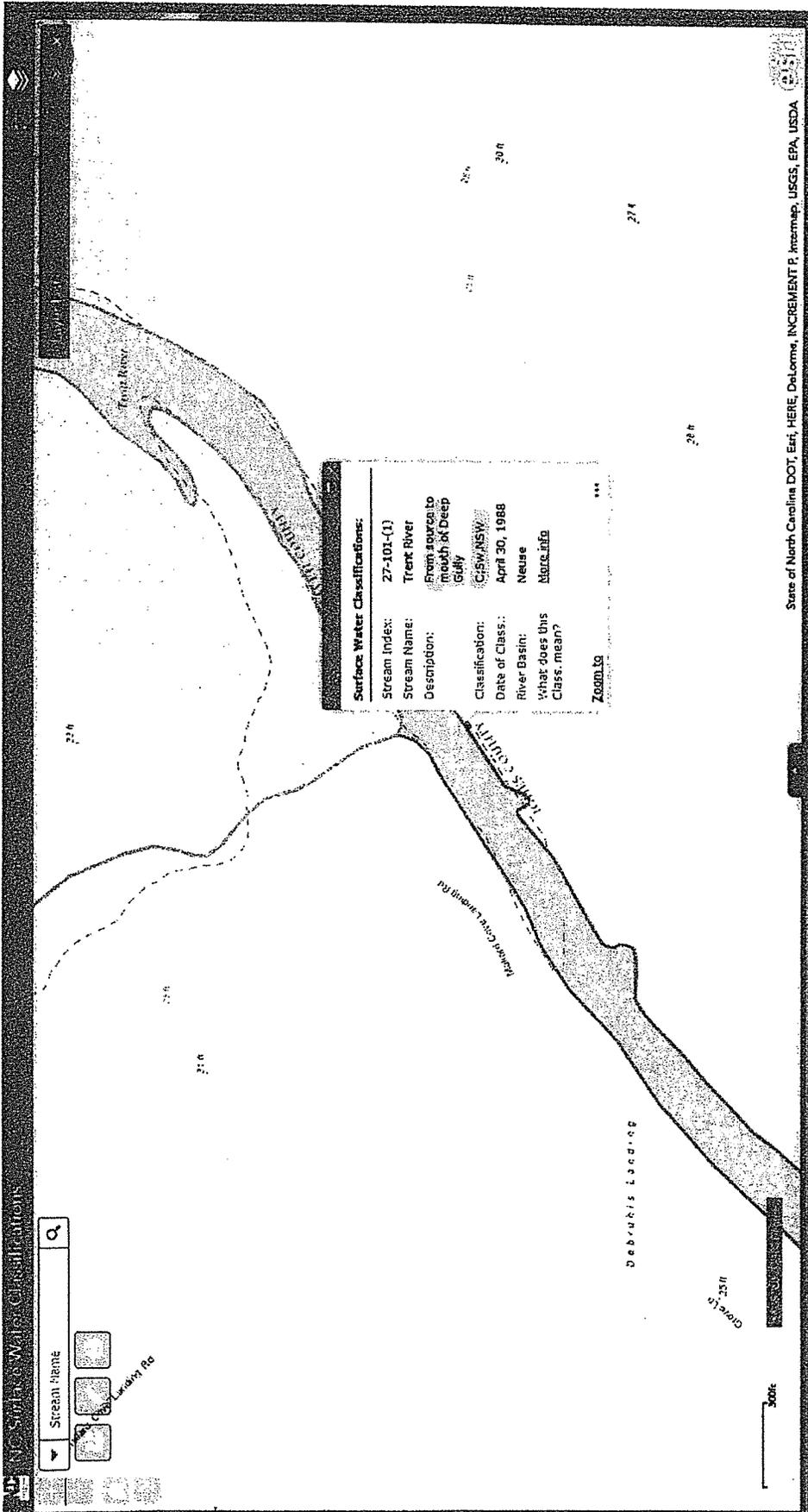

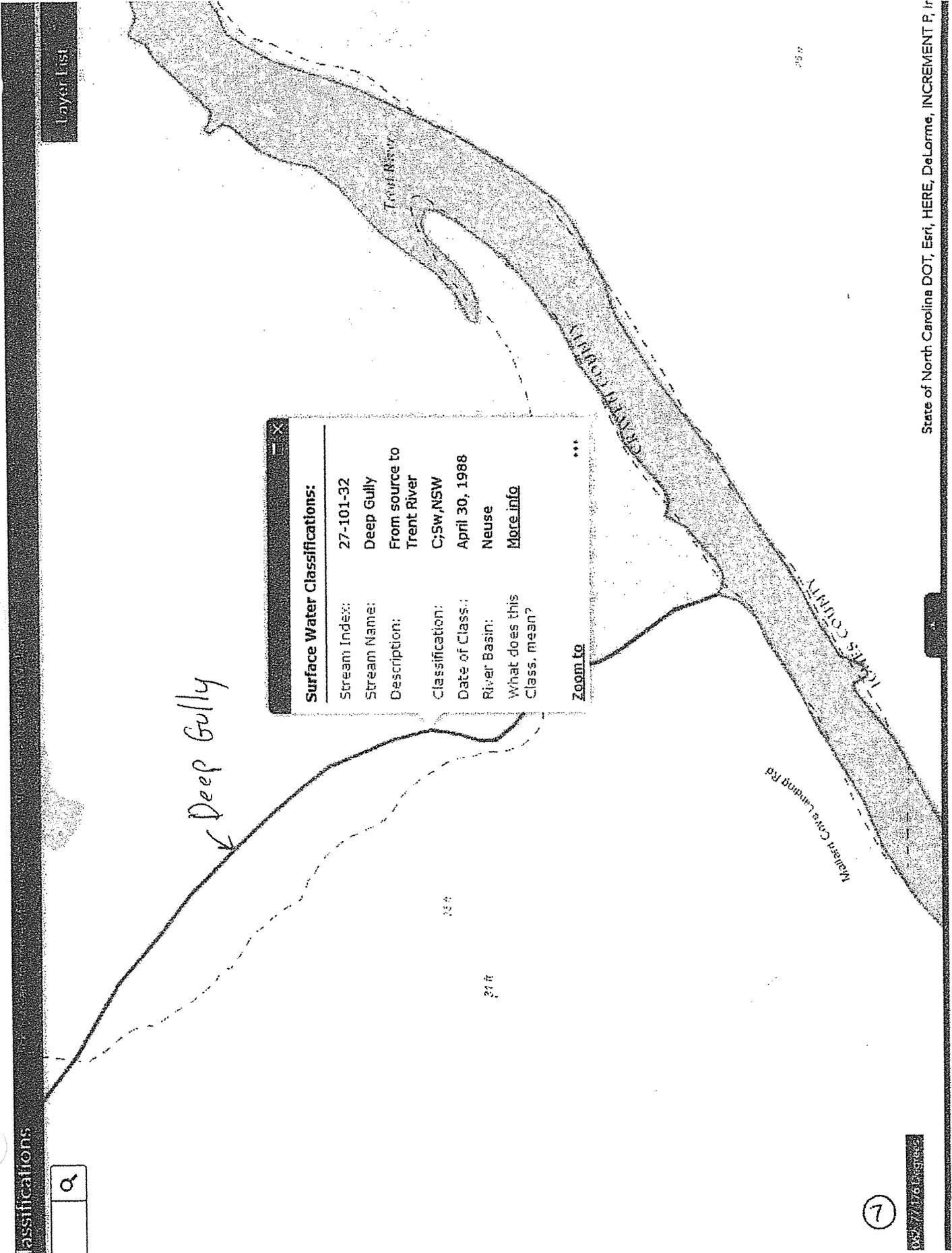
Nutrient Sensitive Waters (NSW)

Supplemental classification intended for waters needing additional nutrient management due to being subject to excessive growth of microscopic or macroscopic vegetation.

Swamp Waters (Sw)

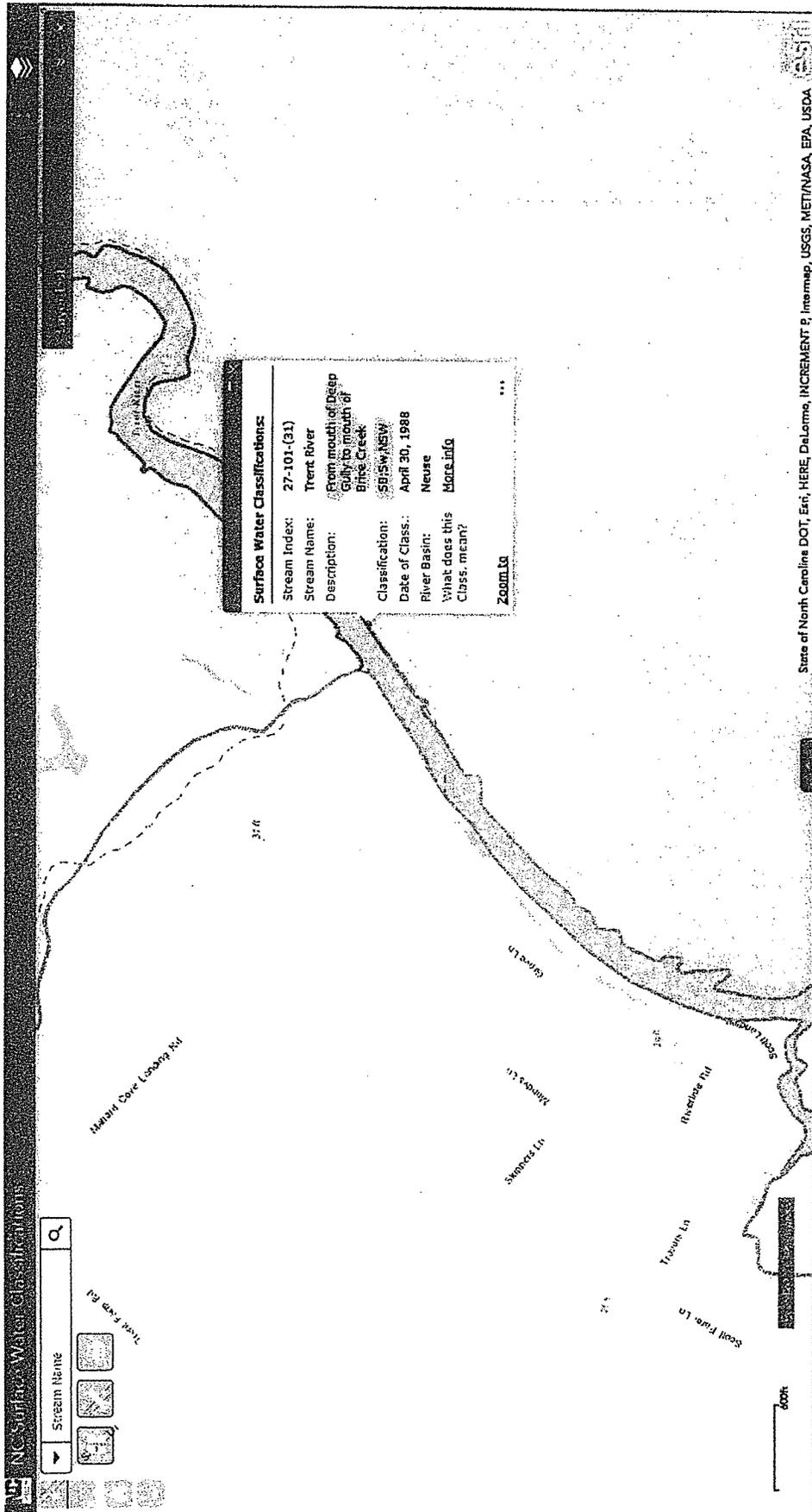
Supplemental classification intended to recognize those waters which have low velocities and other natural characteristics which are different from adjacent streams.

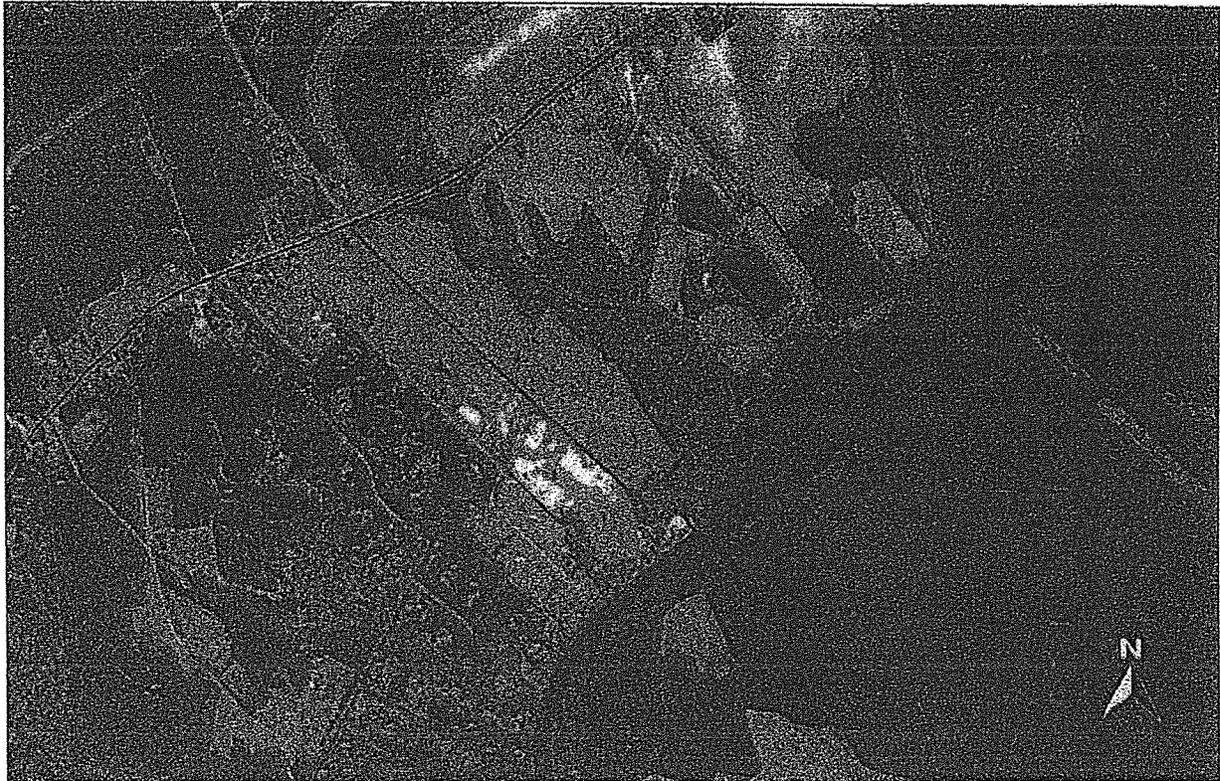
